

## **Claims Information**

We are pleased to provide you with our AllComp Solutions™ carrier claim reporting telephone numbers. Each carrier will provide you with all of the necessary claim reporting information you will need to promptly and accurately report your claims.

Your insured will report their claims using a toll free teleclaim service number:

**AIG** - Your insured will report their claims by using a toll free teleclaim service. The claim reporting number is (888) 393-6828. Your insured should obtain a claim number and contact the assigned claim adjuster for details of the claim.

**THE HARTFORD** - Your insured will report their claims by using a toll free teleclaim service. The claim reporting number is (800) 327-3636. Your insured should obtain a claim number and contact the claim adjuster for details of the claim.

**ACE** - Your insured will report their claims by using a toll free teleclaim service. The claim reporting number is (866) 840-1223. Your insured should obtain a claim number and contact the claim adjuster for details on the claim.

**THE ZENITH** - Your insured will report their claims by using a toll free teleclaim service. The claim reporting hot-line number administered by First Call is (800) 440-5020. Your insured should obtain a claim number, direct employee to call, and contact the assigned nurse case manager for details of the claim and return to work options.

**AmTrust** - Your insured will report their claims by using a toll free teleclaim service. The claim reporting number is (800) 243-8937. Your insured should obtain a claim number and contact the claim adjuster for details on the claim.

Note: The basic Workers Compensation benefits are payment of medical bills and wage loss reimbursement. Do Not Pay Any Medical Bills. Send all bills to your carrier for consideration, as the law may require specific reductions. Wage loss is generally paid as a percentage of the gross average weekly wage and is not taxable. There usually is a waiting period before the injured worker is eligible to receive wage loss benefits.
