When cars behind you want to pass, do you allow them to do so?

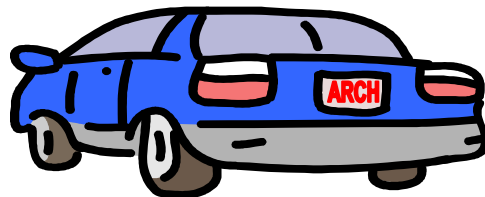
When a traffic signal changes to green, do you wait patiently for cars in front to move – without blowing your horn?
